Falkirk St Andrew's Church WAR MEMORIAL

34 members of the congregation are commemorated on the memorial in this church, which was unveiled by Miss Orr of Kinnaird in April 1921.

The memorial takes the form of two panels inserted in the organ case, one at either side of the pulpit, and in full view of the congregation. The panels are of oak with carved surrounds, and surmounting each is a large Saint Andrew's cross in blue and white relief. The surrounds are also relieved by touches of blue, while the lettering is of ebony.

The inscription they bear and the names of the fallen are as follows:

"TO THE GLORY OF GOD/ AND THE HONOURED/ MEMORY OF THE MEN/ OF THIS CONGREGATION/

WHO LOST THEIR LIVES/ IN THE GREAT WAR,/ 1914-1919."
