

ICI, Grangemouth WAR MEMORIAL

Located half way up the stairs in the West Area Amenities Block (WAAB), which faces Beancross Road. It is a metal (possibly cast iron with coating) plaque imitating in form wall memorials in churches with bottom brackets and a pedimented arched top. A square panel in the pediment contains a lion, and there are laurel sprigs down the sides.
