Slamannan Heroes' Park WAR MEMORIAL

Three square stone cairns unveiled on 3 April 2010 to commemorate Samuel Frickleton VC (1891-1971), Alexander Penman MM & Bar (1896-1961) and soldiers since 1945.

Samuel Frickleton was born at the Old Lodge, Slamannan; Alexander Penman at Loanrigg.

Three chamfered stone plinths contain details of each of the three categories, with white flagpoles between. The central plinth is surmounted by a large replica of a Victoria Cross. They are set in a small public park.
