St Mary's Episcopalian Church WAR MEMORIAL





A polychrome rood is suspended from the chancel arch of this church. It was gifted by a member of the congregation whose son was killed in the Second World War to honour all of those who did not return. The dominant colour is pale blue. In the centre is the crucifix and to either side is a full length figure of a man and a woman.

Above Christ's head is a curving white ribbon inscribed:

"INRI"

and along the basal bar:

"GOD SO LOVED THE WORLD"
