

Tryst Golf Club WAR MEMORIAL

Two phosphor-bronze plaques are attached to the whitewashed raised panel on the white harled north wall of the club house for the Tryst Golf course, overlooking a public footpath. A hood-mould, following the shape of the plaques, is painted black. The upper plaque has an arched centre containing crossed golf clubs surrounded by thistles. The broad border is a simple "chain" interlace pattern.
