The monument from Broompark Church is now in Westpark between two window lights on the wall separating the nave and the vestibule. For this installation the backing plaque had to be reduced slightly in size. It is of white marble with black lettering, and has a square central panel with an upright rectangular panel to either side.

The central one reads:

"TO THE GLORY OF GOD, AND IN/ UNFADING MEMORY OF THE MEN OF THIS/ CONGREGATION WHO GAVE THEIR/ LIVES IN THE GREAT WAR. 1914-1919.

A second monument was erected after the Second World War and is now reerected at the south-west end of the nave in Westpark Church. It takes the form of a large wooden tablet with panelled Ionic pilasters below a deep cornice. The panel in the centre is topped by a carved wooden wreath and has the words:

"TO THE GLORY OF GOD/ AND IN EVERLASTING MEMORY OF THE MEN/ OF THIS CONGREGATION/ JAMES HAUGH/ ANDREW R HEPBURN/ JAMES LAMBERT/ JAMES MILLAR/ WHO GAVE THEIR LIVES IN THE WORLD WAR/ 1939-1945".

Along the bottom is the additional line "AT THE GOING DOWN OF THE SUN WE SHALL REMEMBER THEM".
