Carriden Parish Church WAR MEMORIAL

There are two stained glass memorial windows from the Second World War. Beside these a small brass-plated plaque reads:

"THESE MEMORIAL WINDOWS
ARE ERECTED
TO THE GLORY OF GOD
AND IN MEMORY OF THOSE WHO
GAVE
THEIR LIVES
IN THE WORLD WAR MCMXXXIX
– MCMXLVI."



- (1) The baby Jesus is shown in a manger in the stable with Mary kneeling in prayer to the right and Joseph standing carrying a staff. Three shepherds descend the hill in the background with two winged angels above and a star at the top with the word "Alpha". At the bottom of the widow it reads "To the Glory/ of God". This window was erected by Rev. William Dundas for his wife Harriet and infant daughter May.
- (2) Red-robed Jesus ascending with a winged angel behind. Three disciples look up from the foreground with an open book on the bottom right. Above all is the word "Omega".
