To the Glory of God In Memory of those who gave their lives in the Great War 1914 - 1918

A white marble plaque with raised centre and brass ovolo frame. It rests on an oak shelf on the wall of the north aisle. There is a wooden panel between it and the shelf bearing a stanza from Binyon's Ode of Remembrance:

"They shall not grow old,
As we that are left grow old:
Age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn,
At the going down of the sun and in the morning,
We will remember them."

The upper section of the marble plaque has a colourful central panel depicting St George slaying the dragon. To the left of this is a small bronze plaque with "IHS" and to the right "A Ω ". Below these in gold lettering is "+ TO THE GLORY OF GOD + IN/ MEMORY OF THOSE WHO GAVE/ THEIR LIVES IN THE GREAT/ WAR + MCMXIV – MCMXVIII." Finally there is a large bronze panel bearing the names of the soldiers.
