Dennyloanhead WWII WAR MEMORIAL

A simple rectangular stone plinth stands at the junction of the Bonnybridge and Denny Roads at Dennyloanhead near the Crown Hotel.

It carries a white marble plaque bearing a Celtic cross in a moulded recessed panel on the left and the following inscription on the right:

"IN THANKFUL REMEMBRANCE OF THE/FOLLOWING WHO MADE THE SUPREME/ SACRIFICE IN WORLD WAR 1939-1945/
JAMES COULTER - HAMISH FRASER
DAN FAULDS - WILLIAM STEWART
FAITHFUL UNTO DEATH".
