
LARBERT EAST CHURCHYARD





The Free Church at Larbert was created at the Disruption of 1843 when Rev John Bonar of Larbert Parish Church walked out and started to preach at Cargill's Thorn. The following year a small church was erected in Kirk Avenue facing Main Street at a cost of £700. The building was an unassuming structure with a burial ground on the south side. The possession of a place of sepulture provided the



Free Church with an important air of independence from the Established Church. The building was replaced in 1900-1903 by the present church building.

The gravestones were recorded in 1971 by the indefatigable team of Mitchell and Mitchell and shortly afterwards the grounds were tidied up and grassed over. Some stones were lost whilst others were pushed to the side and placed along the boundary walls, though some of the larger ones were left in situ.
