

The Tattie Kirkyard

The small graveyard attached to the Tattie Kirk is one of Falkirk town centre's historical delights. It lies half hidden behind the shops of Cow Wynd, unknown to many of the shoppers that throng the town's busy streets. It is therefore with a sense of discovery that one enters it for the first time from a tortuous alley leading off Mission Brae and views the serried ranks of tombstones that reach southward to the charming octagonal stone building beyond which used to house the Tattie Kirk.

The church was built for the Falkirk Anti-burgher Congregation in 1806 to replace a temporary structure which had stood beyond what was then the urban fringe, on the corner of Cow Wynd and St Crispin's Place. As they had plenty of land, the old site was immediately sold to William Crawford in order to raise some of the money for the new structure. This still left the congregation with a plot of land extending from Mission Brae in the north to St Crispin's Place in the south, and from Cow Wynd on the west to a straight boundary line drawn almost due south from the centre of Mission Brae. From this plot were excluded the long line of buildings fronting on to Cow Wynd from the extreme north as far south as the new church itself, and a smithy adjacent to the feu given to Crawford, as well as Comely Cottage on St Crispin's Place. The manse, erected in 1800 for use with the temporary church, lay immediately to the south east of the octagonal church, and the session house was

north of that. The remainder of this large plot of ground was used as vegetable gardens, some of which were leased out to raise funds for the maintenance of the church buildings. This, combined with the peculiar shape of the church and its rural setting, soon brought about the epithet 'Thrashing Mill' for the building and 'Tattie Kirk' for the congregation.

The move had, nonetheless, placed the church building into more intimate contact with the urban centre, though it does, at first sight, seem odd that it should no longer front on to a main road. Indeed, it lay behind the end of the existing street frontage. However, this was normal for that period. The Burgher Church at Airth was placed behind the High Street there in 1809, and the Relief Church ([West Church](#)) at Falkirk already lay on a rear plot. Whilst access to the manse was gained by means of a small lane leading directly off the east side of Cow Wynd, the main approach to the church was from the north towards the town centre. A narrow path skirted along the back walls of the houses on Cow Wynd and led to a gate on the road which later became known as Mission Brae. None of these houses possessed yards or gardens, a somewhat peculiar arrangement indicative of their antiquity.

This layout suggests that from the beginning the area to the north of the church was set aside for use as a graveyard. It was not executed immediately, and in 1821 when their minister, Rev James Brownlee, died, the congregation purchased a lair in the parish churchyard and erected a memorial stone for him there. This incident highlighted the need for a graveyard of their own, but it was 1827

before it was formally laid out and lairs sold to members of the congregation. The earliest dated tombstone, [no 3 below](#), was erected by John Stark in that year, though it was December 1866 before he was laid to rest there. (Where the date occurs at the beginning of a tombstone inscription it refers to the date of its erection, often the purchase date of the lair, and not to the date of any burial). [Janet Storrie](#) was the first person to be buried in the graveyard in December 1827.

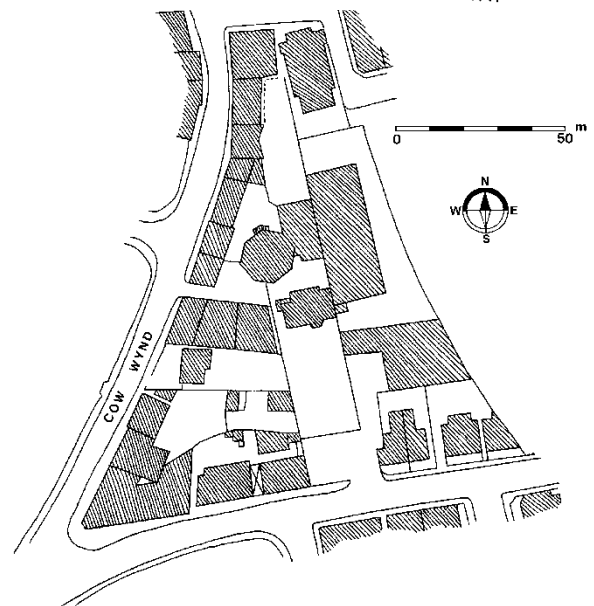
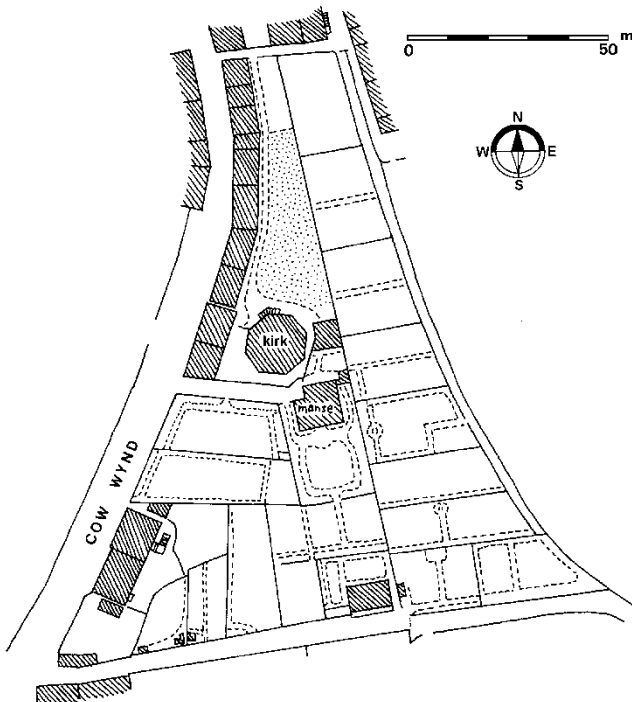
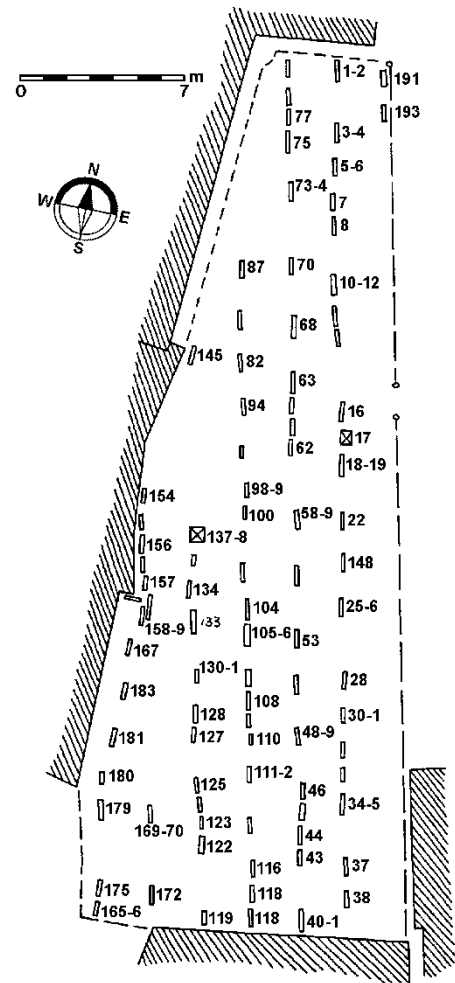
The lairs were arranged in parallel north-south rows, starting at the north-east corner where an east-west hedge, set well back from the road, met the north-south fence. The first row of headstones was placed 2.4m away from this eastern boundary so that their inscriptions faced east over the burials in accordance with Christian tradition, even though this meant that they could not be seen from the path. This row contained lairs 1 to 39, numbered from north to south. The next row picked up the numbering from the south and went from 40 to 79. Row three housed numbers 80 to 118 from north to south, row four 119 to 148 placed south to north, five 149 to 173 from north to south, and the sixth row was shorter with numbers 174 to 186. Most of

the stones had the lair number carved on them for ease of administration. The burial plots were allotted in numerical order.

The path lay to the west of the graves and was the only thing separating them from the dwellings on Cow Wynd. This created a number of practical problems. Run off water from their roofs had no obvious means of draining away, and in any case, the occupants needed to save some of that water for their own use. Thus in 1858 Mr Fleming of Cow Wynd was granted the privilege (but not the right) to keep his water barrel at the back of his property on the south corner of the late Peter Booth's (SRO CH3/122/20). The persistent habit of the neighbours of "*laying clothes in the churchyard*" was a perennial problem. In July 1848 the session clerk was appointed "*to write to the different proprietors on the west side of the churchyard that unless they stanchion their windows and prevent any communication into the grave yard they will be compelled to build a wall before their windows to prevent any communication into their property.*" (op cit). Notices were posted to warn trespassers to keep out. These efforts were of no avail and the subject appears time and again in the church records. In 1875 we hear that "*the tenants of the houses adjoining the Kirk Yard were in the habit of using it for the purpose of drying clothes, and that by means of ladders, these people gained access from their windows.*"

The church did not have enough money to spend on prosecutions. Nor did they waste their resources. When, in 1859 Rev Steel died, the congregation paid for the funeral expenses and an inscription to be put on his tombstone, but he was to share it and the lair with the previous minister. They were authorised "*to make some alterations on the grave stone erected for the Rev Mr Brownlee & get it altered so as to get the inscription put in less room so as to get our late minister Mr Steel's death recorded on said stone.*"

By 1864 all the ground in the existing graveyard had been used for the 186 lairs and it was agreed that in "*opening up of more ground in the church yard ... the ground next the hedge down to the wall - being the first row be set aside for lairs & to be reserved for members of the congregation.*" This meant extending northwards to the Mission Brae. Several of the new lairs were taken and used, and are shown on a feu plan of 1910 (Falkirk Archives a384) and included:

In 1868 Falkirk adopted the Burial Grounds (Scotland) Act of 1855. Apart from elderly spouses, the last burial recorded at the Tattie Kirkyard was in November 1869. From that date the new cemetery at Dorrator must have been used, even though it only formally opened in August 1870. In July 1871 the burial ground at Cow Wynd was officially closed (Bailey 1996, 20-21).

In 1879 the congregation moved to a new church on the corner of Galloway Street and Grahams Road, and the following year they sold the old building with the manse and session house to William Hamilton who used the former as a wright's workshop, and the latter as his own residence. Shortly thereafter, with the permission of the church, he built a wooden extension onto the north side of the session house on a part of the graveyard not occupied by burials. In 1910 William Fleming, Rachel Anderson, Mrs Stark and Thomas Crawford's Trustees feued land from the church on the west and north margins of the old churchyard in order to extend their buildings on Cow Wynd. On the west this merely meant taking away the old pathway and displacing a few headstones. Consequently the westernmost row of tombstones now inclines to the east at its northern end, and the stone that formerly occupied its northern extremity (lair number 148) is to be found in the middle of the eastern-most row. At the north end of the graveyard the lairs which had been occupied since 1864, consisting of two areas measuring 7 ft by 5ft 9 in and 10 ft 3 in by 9 ft 2 in, were excluded from the feu.

By this time the graveyard was in a derelict condition and in May 1939 the congregation of Graham's Road Church made a request to Falkirk Town Council to take over its maintenance. This was agreed to on condition that the ground was conveyed to the Council. The ground was then tidied up but after the Second World War, in December 1946, Smith & Son, dry cleaners, 16 Cow Wynd, feued the northern end of the graveyard from Falkirk Town Council so that it could extend its shop to within 3ft of the Town Mission. As a consequence the graveyard is no longer visible from Mission Brae.

The gravestones that remain are characteristic of the period from 1827 to 1869. They are relatively plain thin slabs, with only two obelisks to provide variety. All but two are of the local sandstone which varies considerably in quality. Some are relatively soft and have eroded poorly in the wind; others are geologically tightly bedded and consequently laminate only too readily. In both cases pollution in the town centre has increased the rate of loss of inscriptions as can be seen by comparing the readings possible today and those made by Mitchell and Mitchell in the late 1960s. Vandalism has exacerbated the problem, and the three stones which used to be supported in cast iron frames have all been broken up. The secluded nature of the site makes it ideal for nefarious activities such as alcohol consumption.

The burial records for the churchyard still exist, and as it is one of the smallest churchyards in the district the opportunity is taken here to reproduce them in full in order to demonstrate the gulf which must occur at all of our sites between the written record and the records provided by the stones themselves. From the latter we could deduce a total of 210 possible burials, with the names of 159 provided. The archive

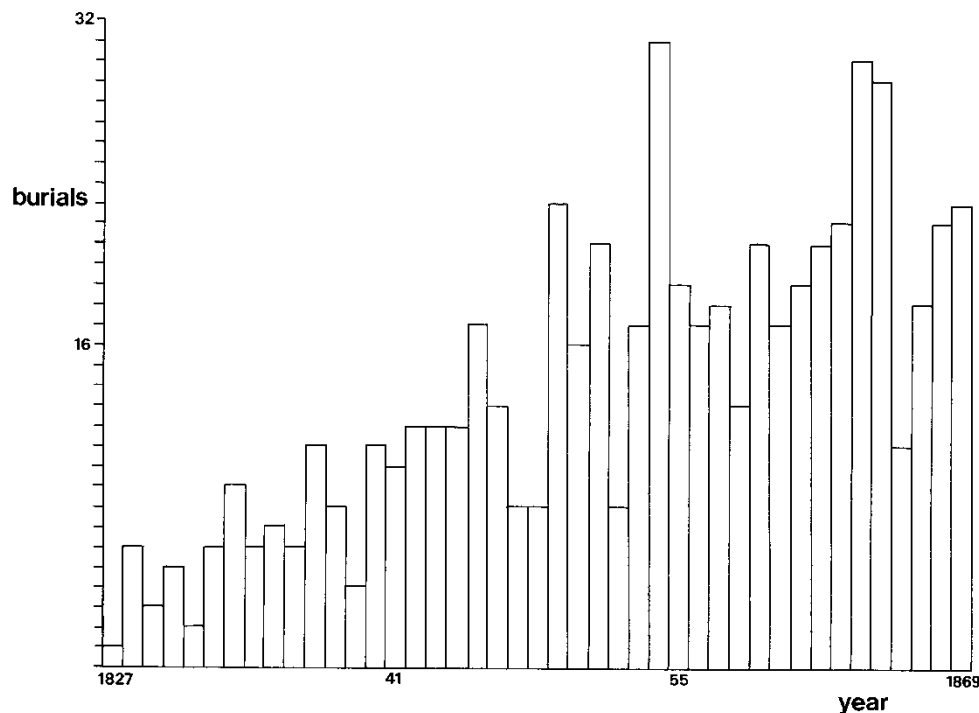

shows us that this was only 26% of the real figure of 605 burials. The figure for earlier periods is likely to be even worse.

Of the 605 recorded burials 205 were female and 190 male, with the balance of 210 simply recorded as 'child'. The age at death of 153 is not given, but of the remainder some 262 (43%) died before the age of ten years.

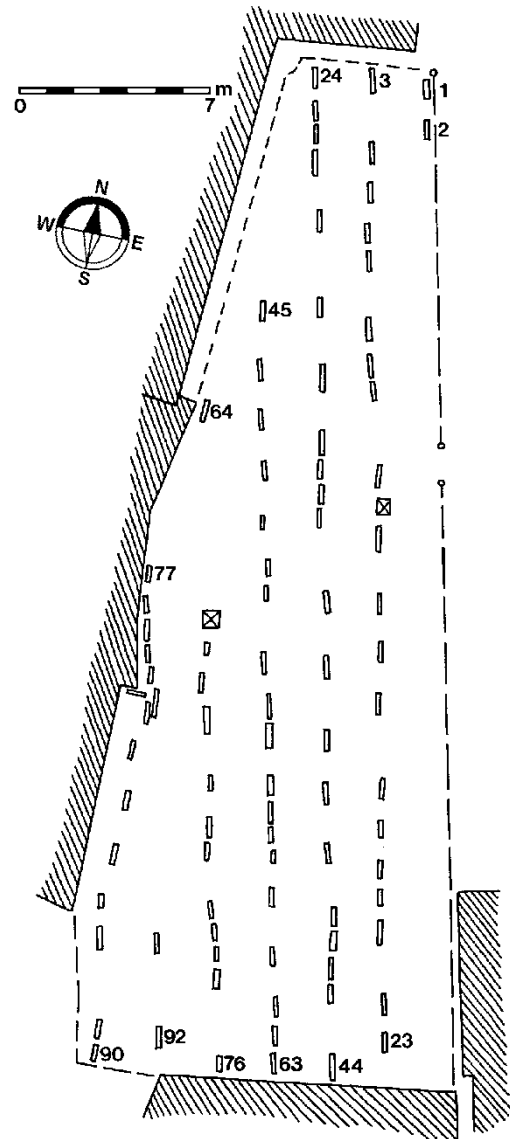

INVENTORY OF SURVIVING GRAVE MARKERS

The format of the inventory follows that used in all of the surveys. 1 - Each stone is given a unique number which also appears on the plan; 2 - the type of stone, whether flat or head; 3 - if a headstone, then the shape of the top of the stone (see volume 1 of [Calatria](#) for the key); 4 - the dimensions of the stone in the following order - height, width and thickness; 5 - the inscription; 6 - the number in brackets is the reference number in Mitchell & Mitchell.
