A ladder large & one small do
9 cheese plats
2 sauce boats & dishes
2 baking dishes (1 cracked)
11 blue stoneware plates
6 soup plates (two broken)
7 desert do
2 cover dishes (both cracked)
5 jugs (four broken)
1 bowel
12 ashets
Egg rack
Dog & hutch
